The problem

Literacy rates across Aotearoa New Zealand have been declining for two decades. Early childhood education centres do not receive government funding for books. Many rely on secondhand donations, leaving children in high-deprivation areas without access to engaging books.

Research is clear. A lifelong love of reading begins between the ages of two and five.

If we nurture bookworms early, we change futures.

Our solution

Little Libraries gifts modular kitsets to ECE centres across Aotearoa. Each kitset is stocked with 22 curated, award-winning books by Kiwi authors including classics like *Grandpa's Slippers* and *A Summery Saturday Morning*.

Every book comes with a protective covering (teachers tell us it's a "must") and is selected to nurture qualities from bravery and belonging to imagination.

We prioritise centres in high-deprivation communities, ensuring children who might otherwise miss out gain access to books worth treasuring.

Becoming a Library Legend

This year we're inviting supporters to sponsor one of our 22 curated titles. Your sponsorship covers the book itself, its protective covering, custom stamp and freight - placing your chosen story into every Little Library we ship. This year, that's 80 kitsets reaching young children across NZ.
