He Matapihi ki Te Ao Tuupuna

Ko ngaa wheako e mahi ana hei pia

He Kirimana Pia, Ngā Pae o te Māramatanga, Raumati 2019-2020

Tangiwai will introduce the contextual background from her PhD research that lead to Taamirangi Sam-Turner's Summer Internship working with He Matapihi ki te Ao Tuupuna. Using the Tuupuna Times questionnaire, Taamirangi was tasked with investigating:

- How long, in general, interviews would take;
- What considerations to be mindful of in the process; and
- How information collected could be presented back to participants.

Ko teeneki whakaaturanga e haangai ana ki taku kirimana hei pia moo Ngaa Pae o Te Maaramatanga mo ngaa wiki tekau o te raumati. Ko Tangiwai Rewi te pouwhirinaki i whakatuuria te kaupapa "*He Matapihi ki te Ao Tuupuna*". Ko te iho o "*He Matapihi ki te Ao Tuupuna*," he kohikohi i ngaa koorero o te ao i nohoia ai ngeetehi o ngaa ruuruhi me ngaa koroheke noo ngaa iwi me ngaa hapuu o te waka o Tainui. Ko te iho o te kaupapa anoo hoki:

- he uiui i ngeetehi o ngaa ruuruhi, koroheke hoki o te waka o Tainui maa te paatai haere i a raatou ki teetahi patapaatai;
- he kohikohi i aa raatou koorero maa te riipene rikoata, aa, ka tuhia, ka taatarihia katoatia ngaa koorero kua koorerohia e raatou;
- ka pukapukatia aa raatou koorero hei waihotanga maa a raatou uri e haere tonu mai ana.
